




## AUSTRALIAN JUNIOR 2010

If you only go by ratings (which often don't tell the whole story, being mostly based on faster games where players don't have GM/IM coaches to guide them through the wilderness of theory) many of the top boards in the U18 were quite surprising. John Papantoniou again showed that his presence at the pointy end is far from fluke, having the better of a draw against Yi Yuan. Alex Stahnke walloped the out-of-sorts top seed James Morris who now needs five wins in a row to have any real chance of the Under 18 title (and even that would not necessarily do it). Anthony Milton beat Eugene Schon with a sparkling double sacrifice and Fedja Zulfic had an opening disaster against the similarly-rated Alastair Dyer (who now sits in outright second and today meets Bobby Cheng on the top board). But perhaps the biggest upset of them all was on board 7, where Anton Smirnov hardly looked like beating Yita Choong until he did – the missed draw at the finish of this game, once seen, is unforgettable.

Pan's Labyrinth episode six (aka the Under 12s board 1) was a much more dramatic film than the previous five, with Stuart Mason finding himself in a positional wonderland and having Andrew in trouble for much of the game. Alas for Stuart, the black pieces invaded the maze and there was to be no happy ending (except from Andrew's perspective), but he can take great heart from giving the top seed a more than serious run for his money.

Things stayed close in the Girls U18 with a draw between the leaders, and four players are now within half a point of the lead. The unpredictability of the Girls U12 was shown when Hannah Derwent (previously 0/3) beat Caitlin O'Rourke (previously 3), leaving top seeds Denise Lim and Savithri Narenthran on 4/4. The game could have gone either way so it looks like the Round Robin is still sorting itself out.

The **Draw Police** report a sleepy day on the beat. So much so that they turned into the Drawl Police, and spent the day booting people who talked too loudly just outside the main hall door and feeding them to Oscar the fish. We don't care how tardiloquent you are, it's the volume control that matters, and a few of you don't seem to have one!

Hobart only has two really hot days per summer and we've had both of them already. If Sol claims a draw by a "triple" repetition rounds may be started earlier.

**Pointless Metric of the Day:** In round 6 (4 for the girls) all entrants scored their scoresheets in black pen except for thirty who did so in blue, four in pencil, two in red, one in green and one in a mixture of pale blue (for the moves) and a sort of pinkish orange (for the times). The main reason for the prevalence of black pens is that the pens supplied for those who do not bring their own are that colour, by order of the editor who is trying to corrupt the entrants into turning into goths. There were no pink scoresheets submitted, unlike round 3 for the girls in which there were two.

Most entrants signed their names at the end of the game but 26 handwrote them. Materials not in strict accordance with Article 12.4 of the Laws of Chess included outlines drawn around the picture of the pieces (2), scribble (1), a somewhat triangular loveheart (1), stars (2 on one scoresheet), colouring in of the holes of the numbers 4, 6, 8, 9, 0 and the letters a, b, d, e, o and p (1 player - I do this too, but only in boring meetings), and a pic of a girl or female mythical figure with a bow in her hair (1).

#### Reading from the book of FIBE by FA Grainy Varg

The Swiss System is a system for doing draws for chess tournaments that in principle pairs players whose play thus far has been about the same so they may delight the audience by exchanging unashamed blunders. Because these draws are usually done by computer, the rules are written in a language that is designed to be understandable by computer programmers and incomprehensible to anyone else. Despite this, no-one who has written a pairings program has ever fully understood these rules.

The Swiss Rules as actually implemented are designed to prioritise the alternation of colours over many other considerations, even if the tournament leader needs to be downfloated 53 scoregroups in the process. It is very important that players go WBWBWB (etc) as allowing a player too many whites in a row disturbs their prep routine, leads to accusations of racism and could lead to Alastair winning the tournament.

The Swiss Rules are irrelevant because the most important thing in any junior chess tournament is that the public display of crosstables should be in order of score then rating (and not Buchholz) even if ratings are absent or unreliable in many cases and information about who has met the strongest field and who has just been favoured by the Swiss Rules is thus obscured in favour of silly carping Zoiluses\* who can't put a set of ratings into order for themselves.

\* As distinct from Zoilas, which are pretty, mostly blackish, cowry shells found in WA, SA and far western Victoria. If you find one in Tasmania show it to the Editor; you'll probably never see it again but he will write a paper about it and make you scientifically famous.
